Activity Introduction

Our school has specially arranged for the children to visit the “Hong Kong Railway Museum” for an experiential activity. Through the activity, the children had the opportunity to observe and interact with railway artifacts firsthand, examine trains from various eras up close, experience and discuss the similarities and differences between vintage trains and modern ones. They have learned about the exterior designs, interior layouts, and train equipment from different eras. In this way, they have gained an understanding of the history of Hong Kong’s railways and the evolution of trains and railways. Throughout the activity, the children were taught to take good care of the museum’s facilities, helping them understand the importance of caring for and cherishing historical artifacts.

Learning Outcomes

Through the numbers on the train and teacher's explanation, the children have learned about trains from different eras. They have gained an understanding of Hong Kong's railway history and the evolution of trains by observing the exteriors, interiors, and amenities of the trains. While on each train, the children compared the similarities and differences between trains from the past and the modern ones with their teachers. They noted that modern trains are much more comfortable than the older ones. For example, they are brighter and have air conditioning, and the seats are much more spacious. Additionally, the children noticed signs inside the old train, such as "No Smoking," "Offer Your Seat," and "Be Considerate," which helped them realize that although train cars have changed over the years, the rules and the spirit of caring for the environment have been passed down and remained the same to this day. The children were able to take good care of the seats and various facilities on the train. For instance, they sat down gently on the seats and walked quietly when entering the train cars.
