“Organic Farming” Experience Activity

Activity Introduction

To allow our children to experience the joy of farming firsthand, our school organized a field trip for K2 and K3 children to the HKFYG Jockey Club Organic Farm. By visiting the organic farm in person, the children have learned about the process of growing crops and the relationship between crops and our lives, thereby understanding the importance of appreciating food. The children participated in a guided tour as well. Through outdoor exploration and a “Potted Plant” workshop, they experienced transferring plants into pots and took their potted plants home to care for them, fostering a sense of responsibility and a love for gardening.



Learning Outcomes

- Through the field trip to the farm, our children have learned about the various crops and facilities there, fostering an attitude of caring for nature. 
- By personally experiencing farming tasks—such as weeding and removing withered crops—our children have learned about the origins of food, experienced what farmers usually do, and developed an appreciation for food.
- Through the guide's explanations, the children have learned that organic farming emphasizes ecological balance, avoiding the use of harmful chemical fertilizers and more knowledge related to environmental protection.
