Activity Introduction

To align with the “I Love Nature” theme, our school specially arranged for our K2 children to visit the Hong Kong Wetland Park for an experiential activity. The children observed the appearance, smells, and characteristics of plants and animals closely using their senses, thereby deepening their understanding and awareness of these organisms. The children took part in activities led by guides, which included videos, lectures, outdoor field trips, and games, helping them learn more about the habitats and behaviors of the plants and animals at the Hong Kong Wetland Park.



Learning Outcomes

- By observing and exploring the wetland environment, our children appreciated the natural scenery of spring. They have learned about wetland ecosystems, thereby fostering an attitude of caring for nature.
- Through the guidance of teachers and explanation of tour guides, the children have learned about the various attractions at the park, and the interesting behaviors and characteristics of the wetland's flora and fauna.
- The children experienced firsthand and enjoyed the fun of outdoor excursions in nature, thereby strengthening their environmental awareness.
