- Learning about the customs and characteristics of the Mid-Autumn Festival

Overview

Before the Mid-Autumn Festival, our school encourages parents and children to unleash their creative ideas together. They can hand-draw or use of recyclable materials to create parent-child creative lanterns, which will be hung in the activity room as decorations. On the day of the Mid-Autumn Festival, our school will engage in Mid-Autumn Festival celebration activities with the children. Through stories, videos and activities, we aim to help children understand the customs and characteristics of the Mid-Autumn Festival. For example, they will learn about the changes of the moon, how the round moon of the Mid-Autumn Festival symbolizes "reunion," and the significance of families coming together to appreciate the moon and enjoy mooncakes, bringing the joyous meaning of Mid-Autumn reunion.
