Activity Introduction

In line with the theme of "Transportation", we have arranged K1 to K2 students to go to the Hong Kong Railway Museum for an experience activity. Through this activity, children can observe and come into contact with railway cultural relics and observe trains from different eras. Children can experience and share the similarities and differences between old and present trains, and learn about the appearance, interior and equipment of trains in different eras .To understand the history of Hong Kong railways and the evolution of trains. During the activity, children carefully use various facilities in the train to achieve the goal of caring for and cherishing historical relics.

Learning Outcomes

 Children can learn about trains of different eras through the numbers and teachers' introductions, and understand the history of Hong Kong railways and the evolution of trains from their appearance, interior of trains and equipment.

Learning Outcomes

- Children can take good care of the seats and facilities on the train. For example, they will sit on the seats gently and enter the carriage with gentle steps.
- Through observation and teacher's introductions, children will understand the traditional Chinese-style sloping roof historical buildings on the building, and be able to name some of the patterns on the buildings, such as red bats, peonies, magpies, etc.
- Children name the similarities and differences between old and present trains with their teachers. Children said that the equipment of present trains is much more comfortable than those of the old ones. For example, present trains are brighter, having aircondition, and the seats are much wider. In addition, children saw some reminder words from old carriages, such as: give up your seat, be courteous, etc., allowing children to understand that although carriages have changed with the times, the rules and caring for others have always been passed down, and they are still the same today.
