Activity Introduction

In order to allow children to experience the fun of farming, we have arranged K1 to K3 students to go an organic farm for an experience activity. Through the introduction of the farm tour, children can closely observe the growth, shape and environment of various commonly eaten vegetables and fruits, thereby enhancing their understanding of food.

In addition, through the "Potted Planting" workshop, children can experience planting a potted herbs and take care the potted plants at home, cultivate their sense of responsibility and interest in planting. K2 to K3 children will also work through the "Vein Bookmark" workshop to learn how processed leaves can be reused.

Finally, children have a picnic together in a natural environment, enjoying the fun of an outing and practicing green living, such as bringing their own food boxes, water bottles, towels, etc., to enhance children's environmental awareness.

Learning Outcomes

 Children can closely observe the growth, shape and environment of various vegetables and fruits commonly eaten in daily life, and improve children's understanding of food.

Learning Outcomes

- Children can learn about various farm facilities and different crops, and cultivate children's attitude of caring for nature.
- Children can understand the concept of environmental protection in nature, such as: animal excrements can be used as fertilizer for planting.
- Children discovered many insects and small animals during the visit, such as caterpillars and eggs on vegetable leaves, snails, and toads. After the introduction by the tour guide, the children learned about the differences between toads and frogs, which broadened their knowledge of life.
